- It gives you the opportunity to ask questions about the employer or the position.
- It can help create that face to face connection.
- It also may help you find out what jobs are right for you and fit your needs.

Don't forget to introduce yourself, ask for a business card, and ask if there is an email list to join or suggestions for other people you should contact.
